

The Exponential Rise of LATAM **Tech Talent**

In the past years, Latin America has become a significant contributor to the global tech talent pool. This growth has been driven by factors such as the rise of remote work and a trend known as **e-migration**, where talented individuals can find better job opportunities without having to leave their local communities.

In the period 2019–2023, BairesDev received 5M+ candidate applications which reflect this trend.
